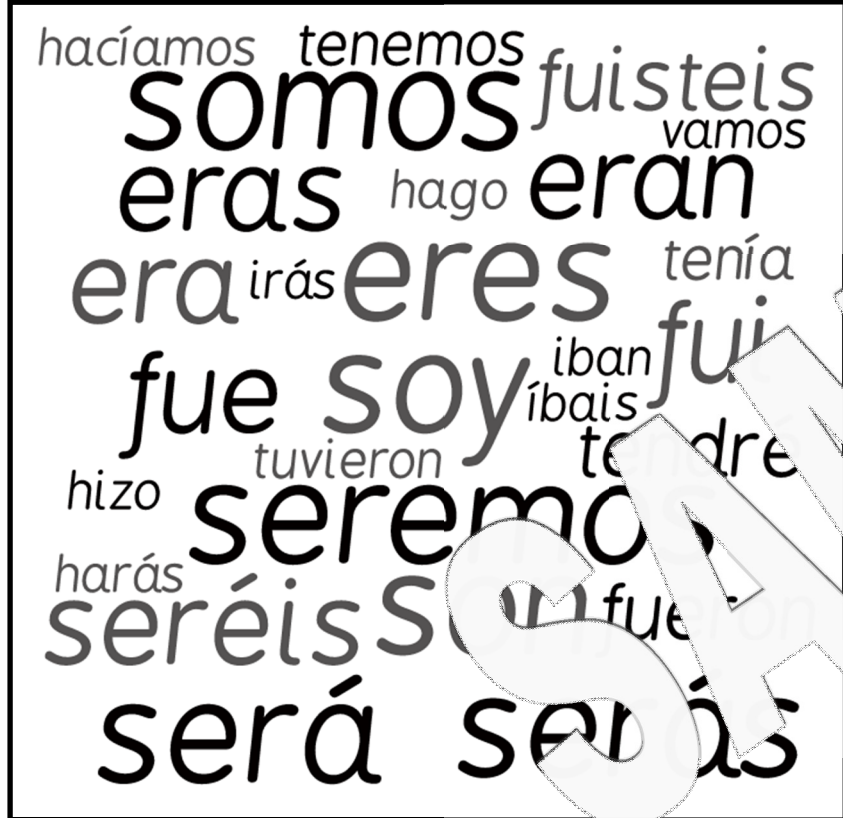

How many forms of the verb *ser* can you find in the word cloud?

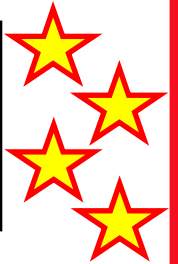
